

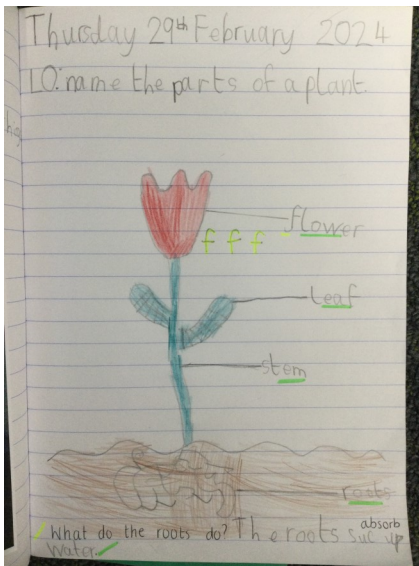
HOLYOAKES FIELD FIRST SCHOOL NEWSLETTER

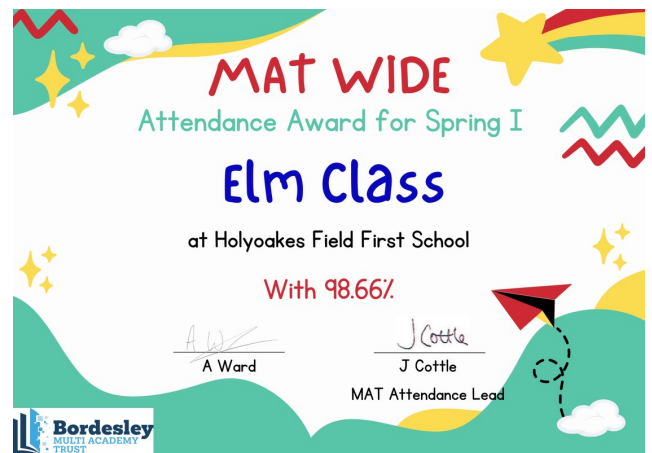

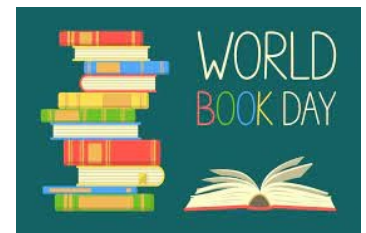

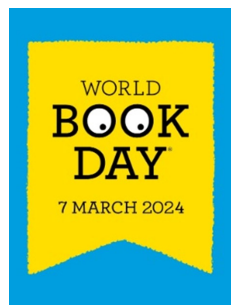
The Big Book Swap:
