## Parking!

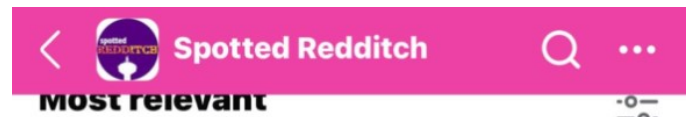
Please see the Spotted Redditch post on Facebook last night.
