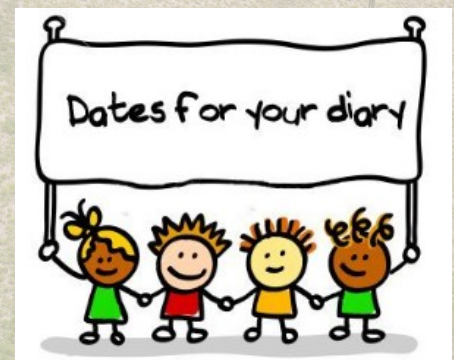

Reception stay and play fundraiser....

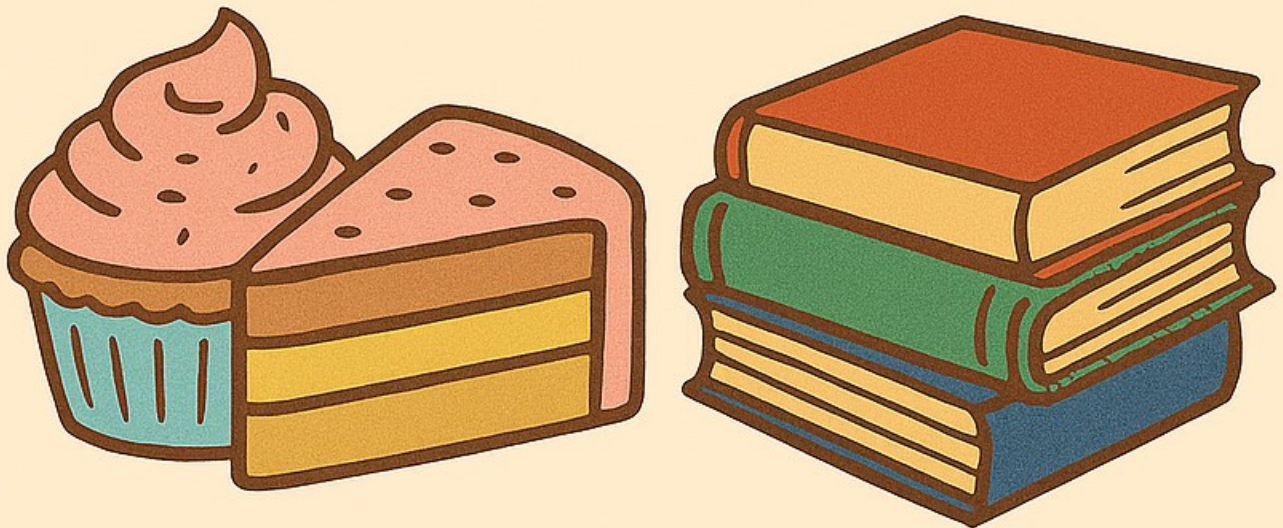
